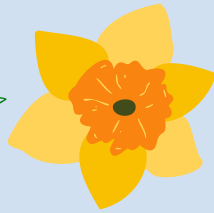
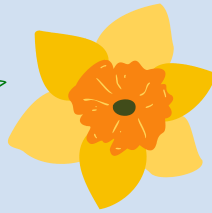


**A VISIT TO THE BANK

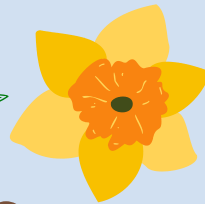
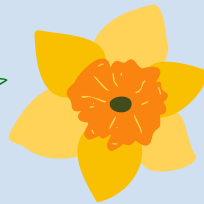
TOY DAY CELEBRATIONS

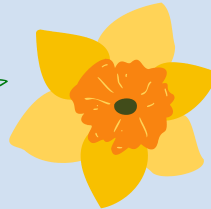




REPUBLIC DAY

A VISIT TO THE BANK OF BARODA

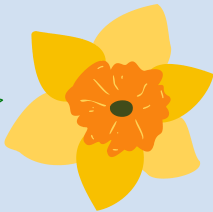
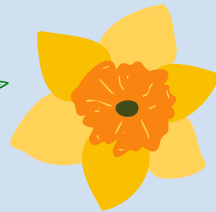
